Continue north on Rt. 4 / 32 into Village of Stillwater; Hudson River will be on your right. Turn right at blinking light (Stewarts on corner), cross over the Hudson River. **From the South and East:**

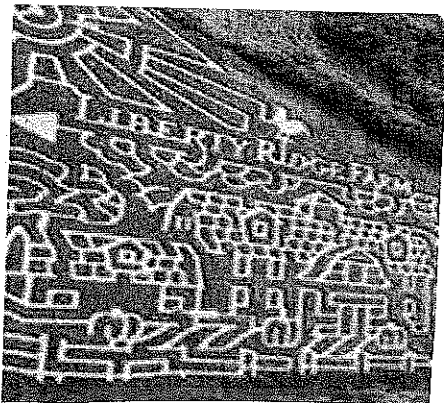
*Albany, Rensselaer, Troy:*

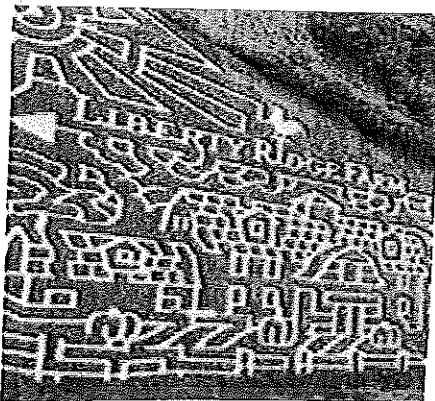
